memory, and so has a dreamlike quality. All the characters are somewhat distorted, as though viewed through a goldfish bowl.

This production embraces inclusive casting. Actors of any ethnicity or gender are encouraged to audition. Actors should be 18 or older. Readings will be provided from the script. No appointments necessary.

Roles:

Iris: A precocious ten-year-old girl. Hopeful, but discovering the world is more complicated than she thought it was when she was little. She desperately wants everything to be like it was before. The actor in this role does not need to look like a child but should be able to take on child-like mannerisms and energy.

Owen and Sylvia: Iris' parents. Money is tight and their marriage is ending. Owen is intelligent, if a bit unexciting. A wartime injury makes it hard for him to work. Sylvia is "happy by nature," but unhappy in her current life; she longs for something she's been missing.

Mr. Lawrence: odd, mysterious, and vaguely fish-like. Possibly an amnesiac drifter. Possibly the reincarnation of Iris' dead goldfish. Miss Rose: a middle-aged boarder in Iris' home. Lonely, outgoing, and frequently hung-over, Rose is (according to Iris' mother) hopelessly stuck in the war years.

No prior experience is necessary, just a desire to write! No prizes or adjudication. All in fun!

This will be our fourth installment of Playwrights@ TAG. For some background . . . a few of the plays from the Playwrights@TAG Festival have gone on to perform in other festivals: The Liverpool International Theatre Festival, the Boardmore Theatre Festival and the Halifax Fringe Festival.

If you've always wanted to try your hand at writing or have an idea for a story and want to see it on stage, don't hesitate. Give it a try!

How to Submit:

WHEN: December 31st 2018

HOW: Submit a PDF or word document to Angela Butler by email at executive-producer@tagtheatre.com or Esther VanGorder by email at artistic-director@tagtheatre.com

Submissions Must Include:

- The theme of your play. For example: a comedy based on the challenges communicating with government, or serious drama dealing with financial stress etc.
- A brief description of the key challenge in the play. For example: dealing with a failing cell phone during an emergency, or a deadline that has very serious consequences if not met etc.
- · A description of the character(s) involved.
- An outline of a setting. For example: outside in a park or living room of parent's house.
- If you happen to already have a suitable script please submit a copy.



Guidelines for Submissions

- Must be an original work, never performed on stage and practical for a stage presentation at the Theatre Arts Guild
- No previous writing experience required.
- TAG membership is the only prerequisite.

 Unsure of your TAG membership status? Contact membership@tagtheatre.com
- · Collaborators that wish to enter should not exceed two writers.
- · Maximum run time (including time for lights, sound & scene changes) is 30 MINUTES. (This is mandatory!)
- Keep characters to a maximum of 4 (doubling is okay)
- · Technical lights and sound MUST be basic.
- Set pieces MUST be few and simple. NO LARGE SET CHANGES.
- There will be THREE performances; April 25,26 and 27, 2019

The Selection Process

- · Producers of Playwrights @TAG will select three (3) plays from the submissions. Just like auditioning for a role in a play, you must be prepared to submit but not necessarily be chosen for production.
- Playwrights may participate in the production process including the directing role if they so wish or provide a Director of their choice.
- · Auditions can be held if so desired by directors or each chosen play can be pre-cast by their team.
